Practice Day Recap:

Braselton, GA. – October 3 – Drivers of the IMSA Lites Presented by Hankook had two sessions for the day with overcast conditions with an occasional rain sprinkle. The track was never completely wet so drivers never switched to rain tires. The course has been completely resurfaced and all drivers were pleased with how the sessions went.

Lites 1 competitor Jay Cochran was the fastest in both sessions with a 1:21.074 in the afternoon session. Championship points leader Gerardo Bonilla was second fastest in the morning session with a 1:22.448. Bonilla dropped to third behind Joel Fienberg in the afternoon session.

Lites 2 competitor Mark White was fastest in both sessions with a 1:24.753 in the afternoon session. Robby Card was second fastest in each session with a best time of 1:25.147 in the morning practice. Card is the points leader with only six points separating him from White.

Lites 3 competitor, and last years L3 Champion Robert Mumm, was fastest for the day with a 1:27.089 in the afternoon session. Chris Funk was second fastest with a 1:27.406 and is the current points leader in the L3 Championship. Kelly Toombs and Paul Schneider had contact in turn one in the afternoon session resulting in both cars to be damaged and unable to continue for the day.

The next round of competition for IMSA Lites Presented by Hankook will be 2:05pm October 4th at the Tenth Anniversary of the Petit Le Mans as a support race for the American Le Mans Series.
