ART. 12 - STARTING GRID

12.3.1 - **"Pole position"** (place on track): Reserved for the car which has achieved the fastest lap time during qualifying sessions, is on the left of the front row according to circuit homologation by the FIA.

ART. 21 - DRIVER CHANGES

21.2 - **Driving Time Requirements:**

- A Driver may not drive more than eight (8) hours total in the race.
- A Driver may not drive for more than four (4) hours in any six (6) hour period.
- A Driver must drive for a minimum of two (2) hours total in the race.
- Reserve drivers are not permitted.

Penalty for any of the above: Exclusion of car, Drivers and Entrant.

Note: Computation of the time requirement will be at the sole discretion of IMSA.

SUPPLEMENTARY REGULATIONS**

ART. 27 - PRIZE MONEY & CUPS

To be eligible to receive Race Prize Money the car must complete 70% of the distance completed by the overall class winner. In addition, to be eligible to receive Championship Points an Entrant must be enrolled as a Full Season Entrant.

Drivers and crew members must wear series required patches as designated in the IMSA Code. Drivers and crew members appearing at award ceremonies without required patches or with patches from competing series or sanctioning bodies may result in the Entrant forfeiting all prize money.
