For 2010 World Speed Motorsports has entered The Patron GT3 Challenge with multiple championship winner Chris Cumming. "It's going to be great to team up with Chris again, and work towards getting him another championship," stated Team Manager John Olsen. Cumming has three open wheel championships under his belt, and all of them were won with the assistance of World Speed Motorsports.

The Patron GT3 Challenge series is broken into two classes; the Platinum Cup and the Gold Cup. The Platinum Cup is for the most current GT3 Porsche Cup car, and the Gold Cup is for earlier versions. Prize money is available to both classes, and races are televised on SpeedTV.

In 2010 the series is entering its sixth season of competition. Sanctioned by the International Motor Sports Association in conjunction with Porsche Motorsport North America, the series gives top semi-professional drivers from the United States and North America the opportunity to compete with such prestigious organizations as the American Le Mans Series in the world's most successful GT3 car - the Porsche 911.
