INSPIRE MOTORSPORTS, BERG RACING LOOKS TO DEFEND AT ROUNDS 5 & 6 OF  
THE COOPER TIRES PROTOTYPE LITES CHAMPIONSHIP

MILLVILLE, NJ June 24 - The Cooper Tires Prototype Lites Championship continues its 2010 season with Rounds 5 and 6 of the series at the Mazda Motorsports Festival presented by VisitFlorida.com at New Jersey Motorsports Park the weekend of June 26<sup>th</sup> – 27<sup>th</sup>.

With a full day of Promoter Testing and another of Practice, teams of the Cooper Tires Prototype Lites Championship will be sure to know the track inside and out by the time Qualifying arrives on Saturday morning at 11:30am EST. And the leaders of each class will surely be looking to defend their positions.

Rounds 4 and 5 of the 2010 Season presented several changes to the championship results of the Cooper Tires Prototype Lites Championship, with a 75-minute endurance race at Mazda Raceway Laguna Seca providing an opening for teams to use strategy and gain ground.

Inspire Motorsports currently sits at the top of the L1-class Team Standings, with two of the team's drivers in the current top-ten. But Inspire will have to make a strong finish in both rounds of this weekend's event, as Intersport Racing and Eurosport Racing are quickly moving in. Both teams also have at least two drivers in the top-ten of the Driver Championship.

In the L2 class, BERG Racing has made a leap ahead, with driver John Weisberg at the top of the L2 Driver Championship standings. Competitive rival Lee Alexander is seated just beneath Weisberg, bringing his team of Factory 48 Motorsports to the second position in the overall Team Standings.

The Mazda Motorsports Festival presented by VisitFlorida.com will begin Friday morning. The weekend will feature the Cooper Tires Prototype Lites Championship, the Patrón GT3 Challenge by Yokohama, the Star Mazda Championship presented by Goodyear, as well as the F2000 Championship Series and the Playboy Mazda MX-5 Cup. The Cooper Tires Prototype Lites Championship features multi-class racing, presenting a dimension of competition as drivers must be aware of classes with distinctly different speeds as they navigate the race tracks.
